

Make your own Wind Chime using household objects

Ever wondered what to do with those old keys that are sitting in the drawer, those rusty old cookie cutters or those battered old spoons that no one uses anymore? Well look no further because here is a great solution – turn them in to an eye catching windchime for your window, yard, balcony, porch or garden. Parental supervision and help is needed for this activity.

You will need...

- Something large for the main body of the windchime, to hang things from. This windchime uses a cullender, which is great as it has lots of ready-made holes in it. Also, when it rains, you'll have a ready-made fountain! Ask family and friends if they have anything old that they have finished with that you can use for your windchime.
- Old kitchen utensils and cutlery • Metal / shiny things such as: old keys, old broken jewellery, old cookie cutters, bent tent pegs, beads, tin cans etc • Wire, various thicknesses if possible. If you haven't got wire then string should be ok to use instead • Pliers (adult supervision required) • Safety goggles

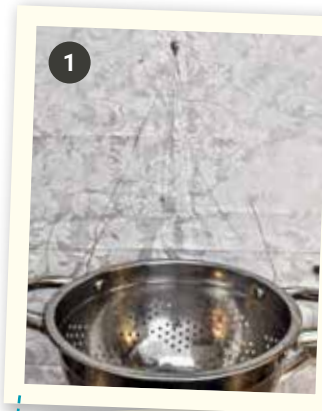


Step 1: Wearing safety goggles, snip 4 pieces of wire/ cut some string and attach them to the cullender / base.

Tie all four pieces together at the top and make a loop to hang your windchime up with. Please ask an adult to help you with this.

Step 2: Now cut a piece of wire / string and tie one end to a utensil/key etc, and the other end to the cullender / base.

Step 3: Repeat this process, using the other objects / utensils. Try adding some beads or bells from old jewellery if you have any. Don't forget to get help from an adult with



cutting the wire. Attach all of the wires / objects to the cullender / base at varying levels, some short, some long, some in the middle. Think about where you place and



position each wire/object – do they look good next to each other? And finally



Step 4: ...

take your completed windchime outside, and find somewhere to hang it – if you have used a cullender don't forget to check what happens when it rains, as you should get a lovely water fountain / shower coming through the holes too! Well done everyone – great job!

Gofynnwch i deulu a ffrindiau a oes ganddyn nhw unrhyw beth hen maent wedi gorffen gydag o y medrwrch ei ddefnyddio ar gyfer eich cloch wynt. • Hen offer cegin a chyllyll a ffyrç • Pethau metel / sgleiniog fel: hen oriadau, hen emwaith wedi malu, hen dorwyr cwci, pegiau pabell wedi plygu, gleiniau, caniau tun ac ati • Weiers, o wahanol drwch os yn bosibl. Os nad oes gennych weiers yna dylai'r llinyn fod yn iawn i'w ddefnyddio • Gefail (mae angen goruchwyliaeth oedolion) • Gogls diogelwch



Cam 1: Gan wisgo gogls diogelwch, torrwrch 4 darn o weiren / llinyn a'u hatodi i'r colandr / sylfaen.

Clyma'r pedwar darn gyda'i gilydd ar y top a gwnewch ddolen i hongian eich cloch wynt. Gofynnwch i oedolyn eich helpu gyda hyn.



Cam 2: Rŵan torrwrch ddarn o weiren / llinyn a chlyma un pen wrth ddarn o offer / gorriad ac ati, a'r pen arall i'r colandr / sylfaen.

Cam 3: Daliwch ati i wneud y broses hon, gan ddefnyddio'r gwrthrychau / offer eraill. Ceisiwch ychwanegu rhai gleiniau neu glychau o hen emwaith os oes gen ti rai. Cofiwch



gael help oedolyn i dorri'r weiren. Cysylltwch yr holl weiers / gwrthrychau i'r colandr / sylfaen ar lefelau amrywiol, rhai yn fyr, rhai yn hir, rhai yn y canol. Meddyliwch lle rydych am osod

pob weiren / gwrthrych - ydyn nhw'n edrych yn dda wrth ymyl ei gilydd? Ac yn olaf...



Cam 4:....

Cerwch â'ch cloch wynt wedi'i gorffen tu allan, a dod o hyd i rywle i'w hongian - os ydych wedi defnyddio colandr cofiwch edrych beth sy'n digwydd pan fydd hi'n bwrw glaw, oherwydd dylech gael ffynnon ddŵr / cawod hyfryd yn dod trwy'r tyllau hefyd! Da iawn bawb - gwaith gwych!
