# Gallery 1

Gallery 1 is rectangular shaped room, around 22 metres long and 12 metres wide, with white walls and an engineered oak floor. The roof has a series of cooling fans which are part of the gallery's temperature control system. It has two glass doors. One is currently an entrance and one an exit to the reception and Gallery.

The tour starts at the entrance door to Gallery 1 on the far left one of the shorter walls. The tour moves in a clockwise fashion around the gallery, eventually finishing at the door to Gallery 2 which is on your right. There are framed works on the walls all around the gallery. The sculptures and 3D works are on plinths down the middle of the gallery floor.
