Draw your own Winter Wreath



You Will Need:

Paper
A pencil
A bowl
Colouring pencils
or paint

Optional:
Scissors
Ribbon / string

step 1 Using your pencil, draw around the bowl to make a circle.

step 2 Using your coloured pencils or paint, start to add in leaves around the circle and slowly add more and more different shaped leaves and twigs. Try to get them all to point the same way around the circle.

step 3 Add more leaves, slowly hiding the pencil circle.

step 4 Fill in between the leaves with berries, or your favourite flowers to add a pop of colour.

step 5 If you'd like you can use scissors (or ask for help) to cut out the wreath. Have an adult help you fold the wreath in half and cut out a half circle, to reveal a small circle inside. Attach string to the top of the paper to hang it in your favourite place!
