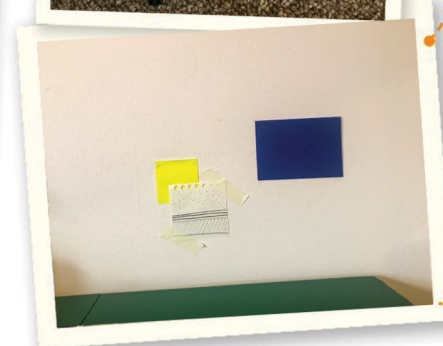
Have fun playing with how you want to arrange your exhibition, be creative!

Building Your Own Wall Exhibition

Inspired by Lydia Meehan's Wal Pawb Commission



You Will Need:

- Pens
- Coloured Paper/card/felt; different shapes, colours, sizes and textures are good
- Blue or white tac
- Play-doh or Plasticine or clay
- Pipecleaners or string or wool
- Things that you can build with
eg. building bricks, lego, jenga

step 1 Get together all the things you need for this activity

step 2 Find a space for your exhibition to go, make sure it's some where with lots of lovely light so you can see it once its finished.

step 3 Prepare your space make sure you have enough room on the wall and have a flat surface of the table top or similar for a floor space under the wall.

step 4 With your pens and a bit of paper draw a skirting board or the bit at the bottom of a wall in your house.

step 5 Pick out some coloured paper shapes and begin blue tacking them to the wall add your drawing too.



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
