My name is Estelle, I'm an artist and I'm going to show you how to make your own miniature art gallery from a shoe box; your very own Tiny Ty Pawb! You will also make some miniature art works to hang up and curate your own art exhibition! Maybe you can bring some toy visitors. Let your imagination run wild.

*You Will Need:*

A shoe box (or similar) / A variety of card from your recycling bin / Paper / Scissors / Ruler / PVA glue / White paint (emulsion, acrylic or poster) / Black paint (acrylic or poster) / Cold tea or coffee / Pencil crayons, felt tips or watercolours / Paintbrushes / Blue tac. **Optional:** Wooden coffee stirrers or lollipop sticks / Empty matchboxes / Small found objects (e.g. shells/ rocks/ acorns etc) / Printer / Toys/figurines (e.g. small toy animals, trolls, barbies)

# Tiny Ty Pawb

**Step 1:** Paint your shoebox with white paint. It might need two coats (let it dry in-between).

**Step 2:** Paint the outside entrance of your gallery like in the example, 'Tiny Ty Pawb'. Mark it out in pencil first then paint carefully with black paint. If you want to add a door to the entrance of your gallery or any windows, ask an adult to help with a ruler and sharp scissors.

**Step 3: Option a** If you have wooden coffee stirrers or lollipop sticks, cut the rounded edges off, then cut to different lengths and glue inside your box with PVA glue to look like miniature floor boards. Once glued down you can stain the floor with cold tea or coffee. **Option b** Alternatively, take a piece of card from your recycling bin and cut it to fit the inside of your box. Paint the white side with a few coats of cold tea or coffee and leave to dry. Then using a ruler and pencil, mark on miniature floor boards. You could space these at the same intervals apart, for example 1cm. Glue inside your box.

**Step 4:** Create your miniature art work! Let your imagination run wild and use paints / crayons / felt tips to create small pictures. If you have a printer, maybe you can print out small photographs or your favourite artworks? Perhaps you like to collect objects like acorns, leaves and shells. Can you make a miniature sculpture from these? You could use blue tac to join objects together. Maybe you can display

small curiosities inside an empty match box, or make a plinth for your sculpture from an empty match box? Use wooden coffee stirrers to make frames for your miniature art - cut them to size and glue round the edges with PVA. You could also use these to make door/window frames for your gallery to neaten up the edges.

**Step 5:** Curate your gallery! Position your work where you would like to hang it, then attach on the walls with blue tac.

Finally, bring visitors! Do you have any toys that can come and see your gallery? Maybe you have some small toy farm animals or dinosaurs, trolls or barbies?

Blwch esgidiau (neu debyg) / Amrywiaeth o gerdyn o'ch bin ailgylchu / Papur / Siswrn / Pren mesur / Glud PVA / Paent gwyn (emwlsiw, acrylig neu boster) / Paent du (acrylig neu boster) / Te neu goffi oer / Creonau pensil, tomenni ffelt neu ddyfrlliwiau / Brwsys paent / Tac glas / Dewisol: Troiwyr coffi pren neu ffyn lolipop / Blychau matsio gwag / Gwrthrychau bach a ddarganfuwyd (e.e. cregyn / creigiau / mes ac ati) / Argraffydd Teganau / ffigurynnau (e.e. anifeiliaid teganau bach, troliu, barbis)

# Tŷ Pawb Bitw

**Cam 1:** Paentiwch eich blwch esgidiau gyda phaent gwyn. Efallai y bydd angen dwy got arno (gadewch iddo sychu rhyngddynt).

**Cam 2:** Paentiwch fynedfa allanol eich oriel fel yn yr enghraifft, 'Tŷ Pawb bitw'. Marciwch ef mewn pensil yn gyntaf ac yna paentiwch yn ofalus gyda phaent du. Os ydych chi am ychwanegu drws at fynedfa eich oriel neu unrhyw ffenestri, gofynnwch i oedolyn helpu gyda phren mesur a siswrn miniog.

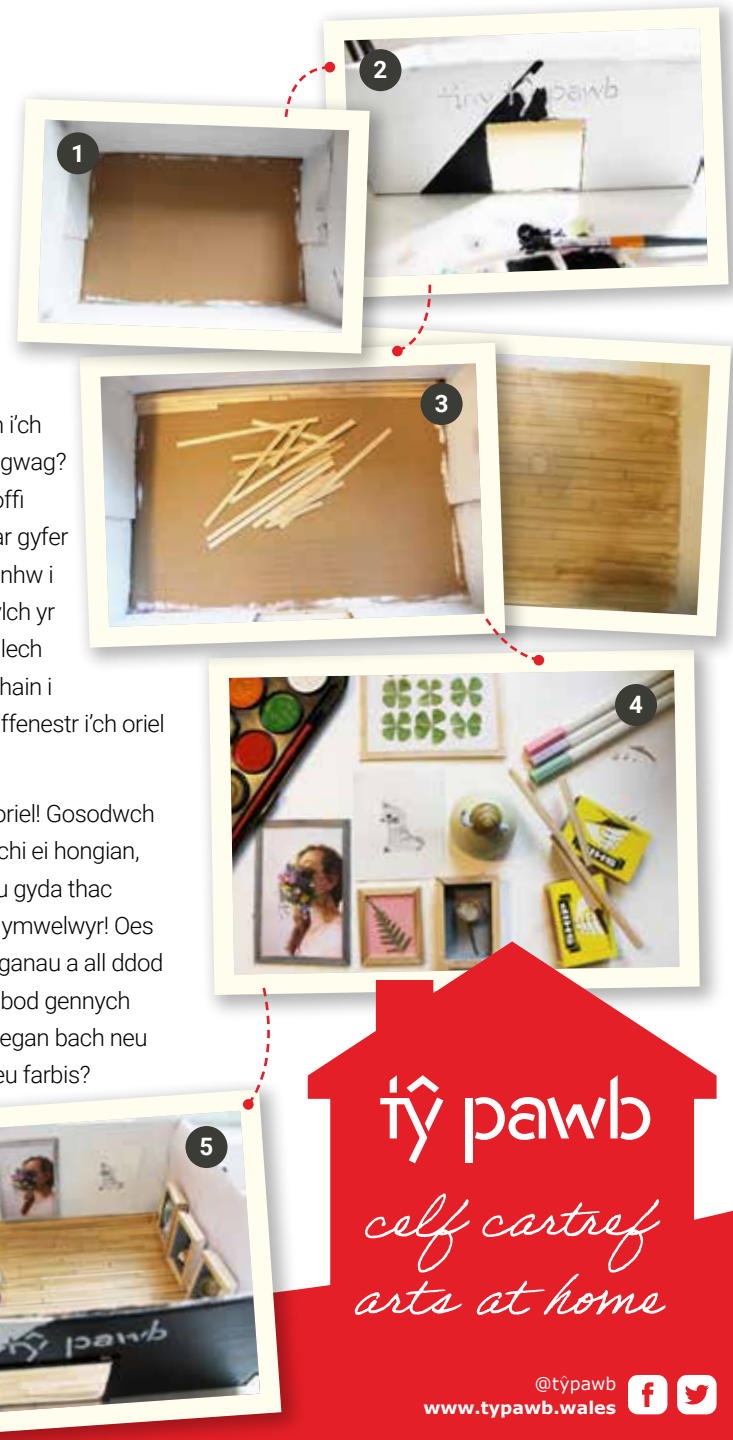
**Cam 3: Opsiwn a** Os oes gennych Troiwyr coffi pren neu ffyn lolipop, torrwrch yr ymylon crwn i ffwrdd, yna torrwrch i wahanol hyd a gludwch y tu mewn i'ch blwch gyda glud PVA i edrych fel byrddau llawr bach. Ar ôl ei gludo i lawr gallwch chi staenio'r llawr gyda the neu goffi oer.

**Opsiwn b** Fel arall, cymerwch ddarn o gerdyn o'ch bin ailgylchu a'i dorri i ffitio tu mewn i'ch blwch. Paentiwch yr ochr wen gydag ychydig o gotiau o de neu goffi oer a'u gadael i sychu. Yna gan ddefnyddio pren mesur a phensil, marciwch ar fyrddau llawr bach. Fe allech chi roi'r rhain ar yr un cyfnodau ar wahân, er enghraifft 1cm. Gludwch y tu mewn i'ch blwch.

**Cam 4:** Creu eich gwaith celf bach! Gadewch i'ch dychymyg redeg yn wyllt a defnyddio paent / creonau / awgrymiadau ffelt i greu lluniau bach. Os oes gennych argraffydd, efallai y gallwch argraffu ffotograffau bach neu'ch hoff weithiau celf? Efallai yr hoffech chi gasglu gwrthrychau fel mes, dail a chregyn. Allwch

chi wneud cerflun bach o'r rhain? Fe allech chi ddefnyddio tac glas i uno gwrthrychau gyda'i gilydd. Efallai y gallwch chi arddangos chwilfrydedd bach y tu mewn i flwch matsys gwag, neu wneud plinth i'ch cerflun o flwch matsys gwag? Defnyddiwch stirrers coffi pren i wneud fframiau ar gyfer eich celf fach - torrwrch nhw i faint a gludwch o amgylch yr ymylon gyda PVA. Fe allech chi hefyd ddefnyddio'r rhain i wneud fframiau drws / ffenestr i'ch oriel dacluso'r ymylon.

**Cam 5:** Ffurfiwch eich oriel! Gosodwch eich gwaith lle hoffech chi ei hongian, yna atodwch ar y waliau gyda thac glas. Yn olaf, dewch ag ymwelwyr! Oes gennych chi unrhyw deganau a all ddod i weld eich oriel? Efallai bod gennych chi rai anifeiliaid fferm teganau bach neu ddeinosoriaid, troliu neu farbis?
